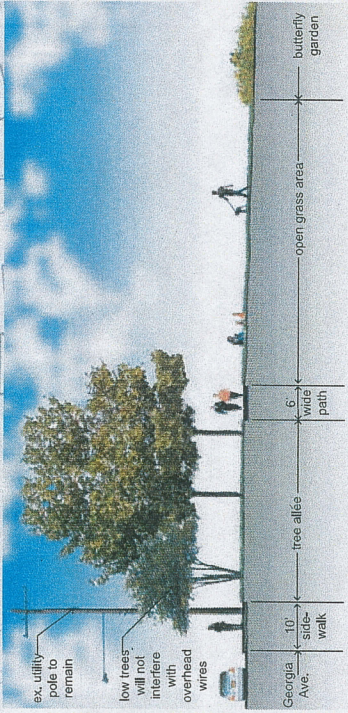

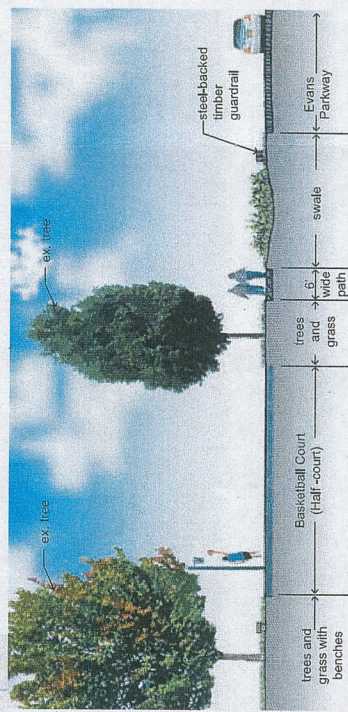

GENERAL NOTES

1. Relocation of existing mid-block crossings will be coordinated with Montgomery County DPW & T to properly mark pavement, including existing speed humps and proposed crosswalks.
2. Coordinate future signage needs along bicycle trail that crosses park.
3. Consider the use of dry swales instead of grass swales during the detailed design development phase.
4. During detailed design phase, a letter of agreement will be written for maintenance of items that are proposed within the right-of-way (steel-backed timber guardrails, turf-block type pavers, planting, dry swales, and bicycle trail crossing).
5. Walking paths located within the stream buffer shall be shifted as close as possible to the edge of stream buffer during detailed design of project.
