



## **NOTICE OF HEARING**

Re: Notice of Hearing for Violation of Forest Conservation Plan #119960710 rescheduled for Monday, January 11, 2010 at 7:00 pm

Dear Mr. McClure:

This Notice of Hearing is being issued to you in accordance with Montgomery County Code §22A-20-(d)(1) for alleged violations of the Forest Conservation Law. Specifically, the following violations are noted:

1. Grass cutting in a Category I Forest Conservation Easement.
2. Asphalt and stone installed in a Category I Forest Conservation Easement.
3. Trailer storage and parking in a Category I Forest Conservation Easement.
4. Horse grazing in a Category I Forest Conservation Easement and natural regeneration area.
5. Fence installed in a Category I Forest Conservation Easement and natural regeneration area without approval.

The Planning Board has granted the Montgomery County Planning Department's Request for Continuance. The hearing in the above-referenced matter has been rescheduled from December 7, 2009, to Monday January 11, 2010 at 7:00PM to consider appropriate administrative enforcement action. In the event the Planning Board finds that you are in violation of the terms of your Conservation Easement, the Planning Board may:

1. Impose an administrative civil penalty in accordance with Montgomery County Code §22A-16(d);
2. Order appropriate corrective actions in accordance with Montgomery County Code §22A-17;



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3. Suspend or revoke your forest conservation plan, if applicable;
4. Impose other remedies as provided in the Forest Conservation Law; or
5. Require any combination of these actions.

Please be prepared to appear at the hearing in front of the Planning Board to respond to the alleged violations. **This is an adjudicatory proceeding governed by State Government §10-201 et. seq. (the Administrative Procedures Act). Accordingly, you will have the opportunity to present evidence and have witnesses testify on your behalf, as well as cross-examine the Planning Board's witnesses. You are responsible for securing the attendance of your witnesses, and you must bring with you any evidence you wish the Board to consider.**

You are encouraged to schedule a meeting with Commission staff in advance of the hearing to discuss whether a compliance program would be appropriate in this case by contacting Mark Pfefferle, Acting Chief, Environmental Planning at 301-495-4730.
