Staff Recommendation

Transmit the attached materials to the Montgomery County Executive and Montgomery County Council, to amend the Department of Parks FY16 Capital Budget to include an additional \$900,000 in Developer Contribution appropriation.

Background

On January 23, 2014, the Planning Board approved Limited Preliminary Plan and Site Plan Amendments for the Parklawn North development (Limited Preliminary Plan Amendment No. 12011030B and Limited Site Plan Amendment No. 82011009D). Approval of the amended site plan modified the timing of the off-site construction of the bikeway connector linking the Rock Creek Trail with the Twinbrook Metro Station. Among other requirements, it required the developer to place \$900,000 in escrow either to be used by the Developer or by The Department of Parks in constructing the trail.

Upon reviewing bids for the work, the Department determined that Parks will build the trail which means, as per the site plan amendment, that the funding will be transferred from escrow into the Parks CIP project Trails: Hard Surface Design & Construction (No. 768673). While the Department of Parks will receive the funding, it does not have spending authority yet. To spend the funds, M-NCPPC must obtain approval of an amendment to the FY15-20 Capital Improvements Program and a Supplemental Appropriation to the FY16 Capital Budget.

Attached you will find the Supplemental Request Summary, Draft of the Council Resolution, and the Project Description Form (PDF) for your review. Staff recommends approval of the CIP Amendment and Supplemental Request and seeks direction from the Board to transmit the attached information to the Montgomery County Executive and the County Council for their consideration and approval of the CIP Amendment and Supplemental Appropriation.

3. Please explain why you did not request this during the annual budget process.

At the time of the CIP and Capital Budget review, the conditions of Limited Preliminary Plan and Site Plan Amendments for the Parklawn North development (Limited Preliminary Plan Amendment No. 12011030B and Limited Site Plan Amendment No. 82011009D) were not yet fully satisfied. As per the site plan, the Department of Parks was awaiting bids for the work, which would determine if the Department would construct the trail, or if the Developer would. Upon review of the bids in April, the Department determined to build the trail, requiring the developer funds to be released from escrow and transferred to M-NCPPC. The Department of Parks is now requesting spending authority of the Developer funds.

Background

- 1. Section 307 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that any supplemental appropriation shall be recommended by the County Executive who shall specify the source of funds to finance it. The Council shall hold a public hearing on each proposed supplemental appropriation after at least one week's notice. A supplemental appropriation that would comply with, avail the County of, or put into effect a grant or a Federal, State or County law or regulation, or one that is approved after January 1 of any fiscal year, requires an affirmative vote of five Councilmembers. A supplemental appropriation for any other purpose that is approved before January 1 of any fiscal year requires an affirmative vote of six Councilmembers. The Council may, in a single action, approve more than one supplemental appropriation. The Executive may disapprove or reduce a supplemental appropriation, and the Council may reapprove the appropriation, as if it were an item in the annual budget.
- 2. Section 302 of the Montgomery County Charter provides that the Council may amend an approved capital improvements program at any time by an affirmative vote of no fewer than six members of the Council.
- 3. On behalf of the Maryland-National Capital Parks and Planning Commission, the County Executive recommends the following capital project appropriation increases:

- 4. This increase is needed because the Department of Parks has recently received developer contributions of \$900,000 to complete the Parklawn North hiker/biker trail for which they need spending authority. The recommended amendment is consistent with the criteria for amending the CIP because the project leverages significant non-County sources of funds, offers the opportunity to achieve significant cost avoidance, and offers a significant opportunity, which will be lost if not taken at this time.
- 5. The County Executive recommends an amendment to the FY15-20 Capital Improvements Program and a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$900,000 for Trails: Hard Surface, Design and Construction (#768673), and specifies that the source of funds will be Developer Contribution.
- 6. Notice of public hearing was given and a public hearing was held.

Description

This project provides for the design and construction of new trails and extensions or connectors to existing trails, as well as trail amenities, and trail signage. It does not include reconstruction or repair of existing trails. Hard surface trails accommodate road bicyclists, pedestrians, and in-line skaters and meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) guidelines, where feasible.

Cost Change

Increase due to the addition of FY19 and FY20 to this ongoing project.

Justification

Connectors, safety improvements, signage, and amenities increase trail usage for recreation and promote walking and biking as alternatives to vehicular transportation. In park user surveys, hiking and biking on trails is the most frequent recreation activity reported. Biking and walking paths top respondents' lists of desired facilities or greatest facility shortages. 2008 Countywide Park Trails 2005 Land Preservation, Park and Recreation Plan
