HOYLES MILL TRAIL OPEN FOR USE

SILVER SPRING, MD -- The Montgomery County Department of Parks has opened the Hoyles Mill Trail located in Northwestern Montgomery County for hiking, biking and horseback riding. This trail joins Black Hill Regional Park and South Germantown Recreational Park using Hoyles Mill Conservation parkland and actual roadways. The trail is finished and directional signs have been installed. Additional trails in Hoyles Mill Conservation Park are still being planned and will be implemented in later years.

Trail users should expect to walk on pavement, gravel and natural surfaces. Drinking water and restrooms are available in South Germantown Recreational Park and Black Hill Regional Park.
