**2nd MEETING ON FUTURE OF LITTLE BENNETT REGIONAL PARK
SET FOR TUESDAY, APRIL 4**

SILVER SPRING, MD – The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) staff will hold a second meeting with the community to discuss the future of Little Bennett Regional Park and its master plan on **Tuesday, April 4, 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.** at Cedarbrook Community Church in Clarksburg.

Little Bennett encompasses 3,600 acres and is the largest in Montgomery County's 32,750-acre park system. It includes a golf course, driving range, campground, hiking trails, historic sites and a brown trout fishery.

The focus of the April 4 meeting will be trails, park facilities and park access. This will be a "hands on" meeting and will feature lots of maps, trace paper and magic markers. Those attending will be asked to help draw concepts and ideas for the park. Staff will then lead a discussion of the different ideas.
