**BETHESDA, MD** – Locust Grove Nature Center invites families and children to participate in “Beastly Buddies,” a special celebration of people helping animals and animals helping people on Tuesday, April 11 from 10 a.m.-2 p.m. at the nature center located at 7777 Democracy Boulevard in Bethesda, Maryland.
