HIGH ADVENTURE CAMP FOR TEENS – SPACE AVAILABLE

WHEATON, MD – Montgomery County parks naturalists invite teens ages 14-17 to enjoy an unforgettable experience at Brookside Nature Center's High Adventure Camp from Monday, June 19 to Thursday, June 22, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Four days of outdoor adventures include whitewater tubing, kayaking and whitewater rafting on the Potomac River and a climbing/high ropes course.

“If you’re looking to kickstart the summer for your teens, the High Adventure Camp is for you,” said park naturalist Tina Stachura. “Kids will have a blast as they enjoy nature’s wilderness and physical exercise that challenges their capabilities and stretches their minds.”

Included in the \$300 fee are: all equipment, transportation, professional instruction and guides for each day.
