**FREE SPIN FISHING FOR TROUT CLINIC SET FOR APRIL 12
AT SOUTH GERMANTOWN RECREATIONAL PARK**

GERMANTOWN, MD - Children can get back to nature and learn to fish at the free Children's Spin Fishing for Trout Clinic, **Wednesday, April 12, 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.**, at South Germantown Recreational Park's pond near the historic King barn in the Maryland SoccerPlex area of the park. The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) staff and the Seneca Valley Chapter of Trout Unlimited are sponsoring this clinic.

Participants have reserved in advance and will bring their own bait, lures and light fishing tackle. A few "loaner" rods will be available. All people ages 16 and older must have a valid Maryland fishing license and a trout stamp to possess trout. Children under 16 do not require a license or trout stamp. A hot dog and soft drink lunch will be provided for each participant. Children will also enjoy a special tackle raffle.
