**PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION SEEKS ENVIRONMENTALLY
FRIENDLY EXHIBITORS FOR SECOND ANNUAL GOING GREEN AT HOME
FAIR**

SILVER SPRING, MD - The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission seeks businesses, non-profits and government agencies to showcase their environmentally friendly products, services, programs and initiatives during the second annual Going Green at Home Fair on Saturday, May 20 from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. in Wheaton Regional Park.

The fair is designed to encourage everyday homeowners to make their homes more comfortable and beautiful while saving energy, water and money. Exhibitors are invited to showcase products made of recycled materials or natural products that can be used for indoor and outdoor home improvements. Homeowners can also learn how landscaping can lower maintenance, save money and add beauty. Nearly 1,000 homeowners are expected to attend the fair this year.

The cost for a table at the event is \$100 for businesses and government agencies, \$25 for non-profits. The fee includes a table under a tent or pavilion, two chairs and lunch for two.

Exhibitors are prohibited from selling their products onsite, however they are encouraged to bring samples of materials and marketing brochures.
