Camping

M-NCPPC campgrounds offer spring, summer and fall tent camping in Cabin John Regional Park, 7701 Tuckerman Lane, Rockville and Parklawn Campsite, 12724 Viers Mill Road, Rockville. In addition to tent camping, Little Bennett Campground, 23701 Frederick Road, Clarksburg, accommodates recreational vehicle hookups for water and electricity, 301/972-9222.

Boating and Fishing

During the season, two lakes offer fishing, canoes, kayaks and rowboats for rent, and pontoon boat rides with park naturalists: Little Seneca Lake in Black Hill Regional Park, Boyds, MD, 301/972-6157; Lake Needwood, in Rock Creek Regional Park, 15700 Needwood Lake Circle, Rockville, 301/762-9500. For a daily fee or season pass, private boat owners may launch their own kayaks, canoes, rowboats or boats with electric motors at Little Seneca and Needwood. In addition, licensed fisherman may fish at Pine Lake in Wheaton Regional Park and in Lake Frank in Rock Creek Regional Park.
