# **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** APPROVAL for the following reasons:

- This site was set aside for this use at subdivision and all new residents were 1. informed of this planned use.
- Approval will allow construction of a water pump station and enable planned service 2. improvements.

Staff recommends APPROVAL of this mandatory referral on the conditions that Rockville engineering staff, landscape staff, and their consultants:

- meet with residents to determine an appropriate landscaping plan for the site
- ensure that construction and operation will create minimal disturbance to this section of Glen Mill Road, which is designated as an interim rustic road.

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

## **Property Description and History**

This approximately quarter acre site at the southeast corner of Glen Mill Road and Sandringham Court in the Potomac planning area was set aside in the June 3, 1998 Avonglen subdivision. At that time, the City of Rockville had completed a planning study that indicated the need for improved water service and this site was designated for a water pump station.

## Intended Use

The site is intended for use as a water pump station. The proposed structure is designed as a residentially styled building and will be faced with brick veneer and detailed with cast stone quoins, window lintels, and window trim (see attached graphics). The building will be 2 ½ stories tall, with a roll-up aluminum garage door on the north façade, facing the street.

The building will be reached from Sandringham Court by an approximately 100 foot long driveway, and the City plans to meet with the residents to develop a mutually satisfactory landscaping plan. The rear portion of the site, approximately half, will remain undeveloped under a forest conservation easement.

This pump station will be an auto-run station, maintained by the City of Rockville in twice weekly visits to ensure smooth operation.

#### Master Plan Recommendation

Neither the 1980 Plan nor the current master plan draft alludes to this project.

### **Public Facilities**

This is a needed public facility, identified by the City of Rockville.

#### **Environment**

Staff has determined that the forest conservation and stormwater management requirements of this site have been covered by the preliminary plan for the Avonglen subdivision. Construction of the pump station should not create any additional mitigation requirements for environmental protection if built according the proposed plan.

## **Transportation**

Staff has determined that there is no traffic impact associated with construction of a water pump. However, the portion of Glen Mill Road that provides access to the pump station is a rustic road, and so disturbance to the road should be minimal.

#### **Public Comment**

To date, no adverse comments have been received by planning staff or City of Rockville staff.

# **CONCLUSION**


Staff recommends approval of this mandatory referral, to meet identified water demands in the City of Rockville, with the conditions listed above.

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



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
