#### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the following condition related to approval of the subject abandonment:

1. That the proposed abandonment does not take effect until resubdivision to combine parcels has taken place in a manner that assures public access is maintained to any remaining separate parcels.

### Discussion

This abandonment is for an alley off King Street as shown on the attached map. The abandonment is requested by Montgomery College in conjunction with the expansion of facilities in the Takoma Park/Silver Spring area. Letters of explanation are attached from both the college and the Montgomery County Department of Public Works and Transportation.

The alley to be abandoned separates the proposed Montgomery College Health Sciences Building from the old Giant Bakery site under purchase contract by the College. The alley will no longer be needed for public access once the lots previously served are combined through Montgomery College's proposed resubdivision to form the

parcel for the Health Sciences Building. A new access to the area is planned just west of the former alley right-of-way as shown on the map, Exhibit "A". The former Giant Bakery property has access from King Street, Jessup Blair Drive and Burlington Avenue.







Request for Abandonment of Alley on King Street

Dear Ms. Curtiss:

The College would like to request your assistance in initiating the process for the abandonment of an existing alley located on King Street between the proposed Health Science building and the existing Giant Bakery.

On May 31, 2001, under the mandatory referral process, the Montgomery County Planning Board approved Phases I and III of the Takoma Park Campus expansion project. The Phase I projects include the Health Sciences Building located at the intersection of Jesup Blair Drive and Georgia Avenue, the Pedestrian Bridge over the CSX/SMATA railroad track and related paths, and the realignment of Fenton Street. The Phase III project includes the approval of the siting concept for the Violet Blair Janin Cultural Arts Center in Jesup Blair Park.

On April 24, 2001 the County Council approved a supplemental appropriation request from the College to fund the acquisition of the Giant Food, Inc bakery site in South Silver Spring. The College has completed negotiations with Giant Food and signed a purchase agreement. Settlement is scheduled for July 2001.

The abandonment of the subject alley will provide a small landscaped area as well as a pedestrian path connecting the surface parking on the former Giant property to the College buildings (Health Sciences building and the Cultural Arts Center).

We have enclosed 25 copies of an 11"x17" concept plan outlining the alley to be abandoned.
