Final Report: Woelfel Research, Inc. June 6, 2003



Research Objective

← To understand the appeal and potential usage of a proposed indoor baseball/softball training facility located at Cabin John Regional Park.



Methodology

← 55 telephone interviews conducted May 19 - June 5, 2003 by Woelfel Research, Inc. as follows:

■ 23 interviews with organized teams/leagues:

• 10 Montgomery County High School athletic directors for men's and women's baseball, softball, lacrosse

• 12 youth baseball, youth softball, and women's softball league managers/coaches

• 1 Lacrosse league representative

■ 32 individual athletes acting outside the framework of their teams

← Interviews captured interest in the proposed Cabin John Sportsplex, estimates of the amount they would use the facility, and current usage of similar facilities.

← Interviews were approximately 10 minutes in length.

Summary

- ← The local organized teams and individual athletes surveyed find the proposed Cabin John Sportsplex very appealing.
- About 40% of the leagues and 75% of individuals surveyed are likely to use this new facility, mostly due to its proposed location and indoor availability. Individuals are also highly likely to advise their teammates to use this facility.
- ← Among those who are likely to use the Cabin John Sportsplex, the amount they will spend per year is considerable: the average is \$1200 per high school, \$9464 per league and \$150 per individual who uses the facility. (Note: this is more than they are currently spending at similar facilities.)
- Finally, teams and individuals are likely to use this facility on both weekdays and weekends, with early evening (4-8pm) being the most popular time of day.





About 70% of organized teams and 84% of individual users felt the concept was very appealing (rated 7-10 on 10-point scale).




Q: How appealing is this concept to you? (10=very appealing, 1=not at all appealing) (Note: See Appendix A for concept read to respondents)





(Based on Those Who Def/Prob/Might Use)





Over half of the teams and 40% of individual users said they would use the Cabin John Sportsplex instead of their current facility.








Potential Usage By Day of Week

Organized teams and individual users are likely to use use the new facility during both the week (Mon-Fri) and weekend.








Potential Usage By Time of Day





(Based on Those Who Have Used a Facility)








Average Amount Teams Spend Annually by Facility

Proposed Cabin John Sportsplex Concept Statement



Concept Read to Respondents

"The Cabin John Sportsplex is a new indoor baseball/softball training facility being built at Cabin John Regional Park in Montgomery County. It will include 5 high quality coin operated batting cages, a multi-use synthetic surfaced training area to accommodate lessons, team rentals and games, equipment storage, restrooms with showers and lockers, and a mezzanine space for two offices, a party room, and observation deck. The facility will be available year round for use by private or public organizations for aerobics, basketball, corporate team building and indoor sports. From November through March the facility will also be used for baseball training clinics and games."
