

Dear Ms. Masciocchi:

The appropriate Pepco Engineering Departments have reviewed your revised request, dated October 15, 2003, to construct park improvements within the Pepco Right-of-Way. Pepco will be extending the existing 69 kV circuit located in the Right-of-Way to accommodate the future Aspen Hill Substation No. 86. Failure of these cables or pipes could result in a large area of the right-of-way being excavated to repair/replace the defective component beneath and around the Skate Board Park. Therefore, Pepco is declining M-NCPPC 's request.

DESCRIPTION

This project provides a skateboard park in Olney Manor Recreational Park, located at 16601 Georgia Avenue, Olney, Maryland. Skateboarding is an individual sport in which a board made of plywood or plastic polymer is placed on wheels and used for movement, performing flip tricks, grinds, jumps, etc. The skateboard park includes a small building for on-site supervision.

JUSTIFICATION

Skateboarding is an increasingly popular sport with approximately 14,000 participants in Montgomery County as of 2001. Because of the absence of official skateboard parks, numerous "hot spots" for skateboarding have emerged in shopping centers and parking lots causing deterioration of pavements and conflicts with owners, residents, and customers. As of 2001, there were two municipal facilities, one in Rockville and one in Gaithersburg, but no County park facilities. The "Roller Hockey, In-line Skating, and Skateboarding Report," presented to the Planning Board in July 2001, proposed construction of three skateboard parks in Montgomery County, one of which was proposed for the Olney area. Locating a site for a skateboard park has proven difficult due to the lack of available remaining space in existing regional and recreational parks.



I appreciate your recommendation that the County, under the auspices of the Department of Recreation, operate the skateboard park if such a facility is built in Olney Manor Recreational Park. We recognize the need for this type of park, and appreciate the community support that exists to promote the development of a skate park. As you are aware though, the fiscal constraints in the County Government at this time precludes us from making such a commitment without an appropriation from Council of the resources for staff and operations.

The Recreation Department will continue to be involved in any discussions about the development of skateboard or in line skating facilities. When the Commission approves the funding for the park development, the Department will then review our situation and consider submission of a proposal for Council's consideration.

OLNEY MANOR SKATEBOARD PARK STAFF PARKING ANALYSIS

The skateboard park would displace approximately 64 parking spaces. Parking counts were conducted during the fall baseball/softball season. The tally sheet is included. Baseball field #1 (see map) is scheduled for use on Tuesday and Thursday evenings, and both afternoons and evenings on Saturday and Sunday. Softball field #3 is scheduled Monday through Thursday evenings. On evenings when there are classes in the swim center, many of the lots are full, as well as on weekends. The parking lot adjacent to baseball field #1, at the northern most point, is not heavily used even when all the fields are in use and there are classes at the swim center. The parking lot on the right field side is the same, to a lesser scale, and also holds the overflow parking from the smaller baseball field #2. There are 42 spaces in the northern lot and 34 in the right field lot. Use of the adjacent parking lot at the rear of the swim center, where the service entrance is located, will increase as another offsetting parking lot.

Various types and sizes of delivery trucks make weekly deliveries to the Swim Center, including deliveries of chemicals for the pool's water treatment and filtration systems. The proposed skateboard park drop-off is adjacent to this service entrance and will improve delivery access.


As part of the design phase, the parking counts will resume in May 04 during the spring baseball/softball seasons. The counts will occur after school and in the evening before dusk to correlate with the use of a skateboard park. Once the school year ends, counts will need to be taken in the early afternoons. The two parking lots along the side of the swim center and across the driveway were mostly full. The one across the drive holds overflow from softball field #3.

The attached Swim Center schedule is part of the analysis. Currently it is open at 6:00 a.m. through the week and 9:00 a.m. on weekends. The center closes at 8:00 p.m. on Sundays, 9:00 and 9:30 p.m., respectively, on Friday and Saturday, and then 10 p.m. the other evenings. The schedule is quite full during the school year.
