SUBJECT:

Worksession on Amendment to Park Master Plan for Woodstock Equestrian Park

On March 18, 2004, a public hearing was held on proposed amendments to the Woodstock Equestrian Park Master Plan that was approved and adopted by the Planning Board in January 2002.
