SUBJECT: Upper Rock Creek Area Master Plan Sectional Map Amendment

RECOMMENDATION:

Approval to file a Sectional Map Amendment to implement

recommendations of the Approved and Adopted Upper Rock

Creek Area Master Plan

BACKGROUND

The District Council approved the Upper Rock Creek Area Master Plan on February 24, The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning 2004, by Resolution 15-519. Commission adopted the approved plan on April 21, 2004, by Resolution 04-06.

After the approval and adoption of a master plan, a Sectional Map Amendment (SMA) is filed to put the master plan's zoning recommendations into place. The Upper Rock Creek Area Master Plan recommends zoning reclassifications for five properties in the master plan area. Because several of the properties are now in two zones, this Sectional Map Amendment proposes a total of nine reclassifications to implement master plan recommendations.

This Sectional Map Amendment also proposes to adjust zoning boundaries in nine cases to place lots entirely in a single zone. Lines in the previous SMA done in Upper Rock Creek, G-516, in many areas followed property lines that predated subdivision of the property. For some of these subdivisions, zoning boundaries that clearly split individual properties are shown on record plats; for others no such clear delineation is shown. Where record plats show zoning boundaries splitting properties, the split zones have been left in place. Where no clear delineation is shown, this SMA proposes to adjust the zoning line so that properties are in a single zone, which conforms to the practice of recording a single zone for each property.

The acreage in the Upper Rock Creek Area Master Plan totals about 11,167 acres. Of this total, approximately 337 acres are included in the proposed amendment to the Shady Grove Sector Plan and are therefore not included in this Sectional Map Amendment. This SMA therefore includes about 10,830 acres. This Sectional Map Amendment proposes to reclassify approximately 904 acres; the remaining 9,926 acres are proposed to reconfirm their existing zones.

There are no pending zoning cases within the boundaries of the proposed Upper Rock Creek Area Sectional Map Amendment.
