RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the following condition related to approval of the subject abandonment:

That the proposed abandonment become effective simultaneously with the recordation of the record plat for the resubdivision of Wheaton Forest, Parcels 13 and 14, Block B, to facilitate the redevelopment of this tract into townhouses and auxiliary retail space located above the Wheaton Metrorail station kiss-and-ride lot. This paper alley will no longer be needed and is in direct conflict with the proposed redevelopment.

DISCUSSION

This abandonment is for a portion of an alley extending south from Reedie Drive as shown on the third page of Attachment A. As noted in Attachment A, the Executive held a public hearing on case AB 666 on December 8, 2004. In December, staff requested that the Executive's public hearing record be held open on case AB 666 pending Planning Board review of the associated Wheaton Forest subdivision case.

A more southerly portion of the same alley was abandoned on the parcel adjacent to the Wheaton Metrorail station as part of case AB 649 in December 2001. The formal submission for case AB 666 includes a relatively small technical modification concerning planimetric coordination with case AB 649. In essence, the abandonment plan, as originally described in Attachment A, requested abandonment of 340 square feet that was already abandoned as part of case AB 649. Attachment B describes the modification.

The abandonment is requested on behalf of The Bozzuto Group, Housing Opportunities Commission of Montgomery County and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority to develop the Wheaton Metrorail site that presently houses the Kiss and Ride, short-term parking, and station entrance. The proposed development, being reviewed as Preliminary Plan No. 1-05021, will consist of a multi-family residential building containing approximately 180 residential dwelling units and 2,000 square feet of auxiliary retail space located both adjacent to and directly on top of the Wheaton Metrorail station. The proposed abandonment is essential to the redevelopment of this site.

The alley, unless abandoned, conflicts with the proposed site plan. The alley will no longer be needed for public access once the lots served are combined through the proposed resubdivision and re-platting of the property to form residential lots.







Dear Ms. Brenneman and Mr. Cassedy:

On behalf of Bozzuto Development Company ("Bozzuto"), The Housing Opportunities Commission of Montgomery County, MD ("HOC") and The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority ("WMATA"), please accept this letter and attached materials as a technical modification to abandonment petition AB 666 to the County Executive and County Council for abandonment of an unused portion of a 20-foot alley, located in Block B, in the Wheaton Forest subdivision. Hearing Examiner Joseph Beach held our hearing for AB 666 on December 8, 2004. The record continues to remain open until the Montgomery County Planning Board conducts a hearing on the Preliminary Plan of Subdivision for the redevelopment of the Wheaton Metrorail Kiss & Ride site. At that hearing (scheduled for March 10, 2005), the Planning Board may offer comments regarding the abandonment.

In preparation for our Preliminary Plan hearing, M-NCPPC Technical Staff noticed that a small portion of the same alley to the south was included in the legal description and on the abandonment exhibit plat for AB 666. As you may recall, a few years ago, Bozzuto and Eakin/Youngentob Associates jointly requested that the portion of the same alley be abandoned on the parcel adjacent to the Wheaton Metro station (AB 649). Thus, as M-NCPPC Staff correctly pointed out, this portion of the alley already had been included as part of AB 649 (but apparently has not yet been platted). Staff requested that we

eliminate this strip of the alley from our application (the strip of land would then be platted separately by the beneficiaries of that abandonment). Thus, we are enclosing a revised legal description and abandonment plat that reflects the removal of the property in question. This technical modification does not affect, in any way, the presentation we made before the Hearing Examiner, the materials submitted as part of the application or the testimony offered at our abandonment hearing.

Thank you for your consideration regarding this matter. We trust that you will forward these materials to the Hearing Examiner and that Staff and the Planning Board will forward their comments, if any, to Hearing Examiner once the preliminary plan hearing occurs on March 10, 2005. DESCRIPTION OF A PORTION OF A 20' ALLEY WHEATON FOREST PLAT NO. 2306 WHEATON (13TH) ELECTION DISTRICT MONTGOMERY COUNTY, MARYLAND

Being a portion of a 20' Alley as shown on a plat entitled "Blocks A, B, C & D, Wheaton Forest" recorded as Plat No. 2306 among the Land Records of Montgomery, Maryland, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning for the same at a point marking the easterly line of the 20' alley and the southerly right-of-way line of Reedie Drive, 60' wide, as shown on the aforesaid plat (Plat No. 2306); thence leaving said southerly right-of-way line of Reedie Drive and running with the easterly line of said 20' alley

- 1.) South 15° 05' 17" East, 185.55 feet to a point marking a westerly corner of Parcel 5. Block "B", Wheaton Forest recorded as Plat No. 22389 among the aforesaid Land Records, said point also being 10.01 feet southeasterly from the northwesterly corner of the aforesaid Parcel 5, Block "B"; thence running with the westerly line of said Parcel 5. - 3.) South 17° 40' 53" West, 20.00 feet to a point; thence running with said westerly line of the 20' alley the following two (2) courses and distances
- 4.) North 18° 19' 07" West, 79.37 feet to a point; thence
- 5.) North 15° 05' 17" West, 186.62 feet to a point lying on the aforesaid southerly right-ofway line of Reedie Drive; thence leaving said westerly line of the 20' alley and running with said southerly right-of-way line of Reedie Drive
- 6.) North 76° 22' 03" East, 20.01 feet to the point of beginning containing 5,303 square feet or 0.12174 acres of land.
