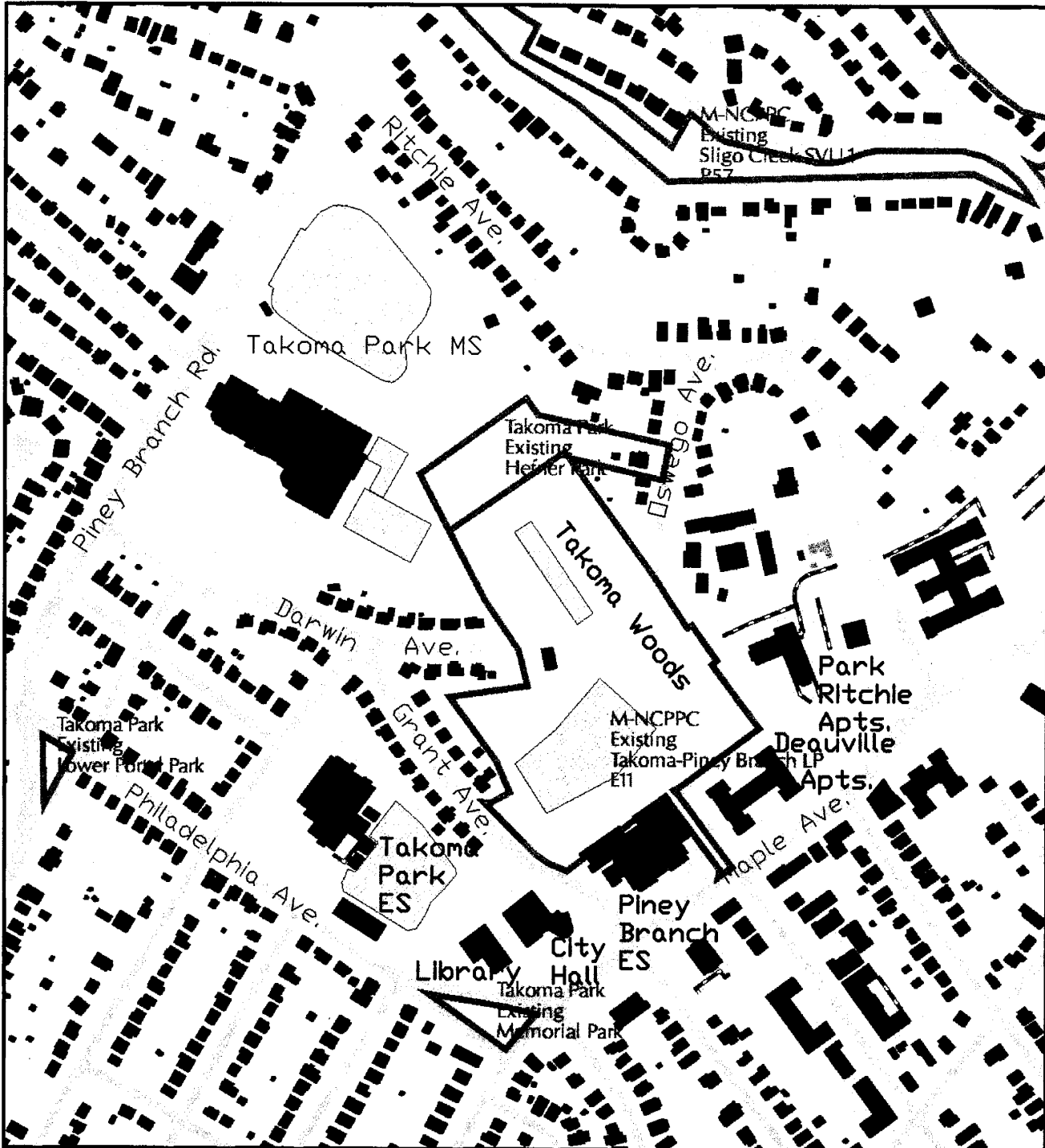


TAKOMA-PINEY BRANCH LOCAL PARK

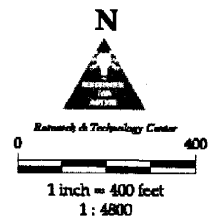
