Dear Mr. Soukup:

The subject property is identified as Parcel P711 on County Tax Map JT11 and consists of approximately 91.88 acres of land located on both sides of Batchellors Forest Road near Farquhar Middle School in Olney, Maryland (the "Property"). The Olney Master Plan, recently amended and adopted by the District Council (on March 15, 2005), recommends rezoning the Property to the RNC (Rural Neighborhood Cluster) Zone with 0.33 unit per acre and 0.40 unit per acre with Moderately-Priced Dwelling Units (MPDU) using the optional method of development. Under the optional method of development, community water and sewer are required. Within approximately six months, the Property will be comprehensively rezoned to the RNC Zone through the sectional map amendment process. Therefore, in accordance with the recommendation of the Olney Master Plan, we are submitting the attached Water/Sewer Service Area Category Change Request to change the existing water and sewer categories for the Property to W-3 and S-3, respectively.






