Amendment to Forest Conservation Plan

Dear Jeff:

Many thanks for your assistance with the forest conservation amendment. As the attorney for Sunrise, I am authorized to confirm that, pending the Planning Board's January 5, 2006 consideration and action concerning the proposed amendment to the approved Forest Conservation Plan, Sunrise voluntarily agrees to forbear from taking any actions in pursuit of its implementation of its sediment and erosion control permit, including without limitation, site disturbing activities for which a Forest Conservation Plan approval is required. More particularly, Sunrise will forbear from such activities as installing tree protection fencing and sediment control devices, root pruning, grading, and/or removing forest and trees.¹

Sunrise will not conduct any clearing or grading in advance of the Planning Board's anticipated January 5, 2006 action concerning the Forest Conservation Plan amendment. Accordingly, Sunrise will not pursue any request for a final inspection or

"sign off" regarding the existing final Forest Conservation Plan in the interim, i.e., prior to the Planning Board's January 5, 2006 hearing date and their consideration and action. Sunrise further acknowledges that a necessary precondition to the implementation of Sunrise's existing Forest Conservation Plan is a final on-site inspection, which has not been conducted, and which Sunrise will not request in the interim.

I would appreciate your checking to determine whether, provided the Planning Board approves the Forest Conservation Plan amendment on January 5, 2006, Sunrise will then be able to proceed immediately thereafter to duly comply with the Forest Conservation Plan, as amended, without awaiting a written Planning Board opinion.

Please be assured that Sunrise's engineers are sending the notices about the submission to M-NCPPC of the Forest Conservation Plan amendment. We understand that the Planning Staff is sending the notices regarding the January 5, 2006 hearing.




