Cloverly-Norwood Planning Area

WSCCR 06A-CLO-01: Howard; 14307, 14309, & 14311 Drayton Ave.; 0.53 ac. zoned RE-2C; requesting S-1 for three houses to be built on existing vacant lots. Staff recommends approval of this request.

WSCCR 06A-CLO-02: Dompka; 14313 Drayton Ave.; 0.19 ac. zoned RE-2C; requesting S-1 for one house to be built on existing vacant lot. Staff recommends approval of this request.

Fairland-Beltsville Planning Area

WSCCR 03A-FAL-01: McIntyre; 2720 Duvall Rd.; 2.39 ac. zoned R-200; requesting S-1 to mitigate a health problem (septic). Staff recommends approval of this request.




