

APPROVED MINUTES

The Montgomery County Planning Board met in regular session on Thursday, February 7, 2013, at 9:10 a.m. in the Montgomery Regional Office in Silver Spring, Maryland, and adjourned at 5:55 p.m.

Present were Chair Françoise M. Carrier, Vice Chair Marye Wells-Harley, and Commissioners Casey Anderson, Norman Dreyfuss, and Amy Presley.

In compliance with §10-509(c)(2), State Government Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, the following is a report of the Board's Closed Session:

The Board convened at 9:15 a.m. in the third floor conference room to take up Item 5 in Closed Session, on motion of Commissioner Presley, seconded by Vice Chair Wells-Harley, with Chair Carrier, Vice Chair Wells-Harley, and Commissioners Anderson, Dreyfuss, and Presley present and voting in favor of the motion. The meeting was closed under authority of Annotated Code of Maryland, State Government Article, §10-508(a)(7), to consult with counsel to obtain legal advice.

Also present for all or part of the Closed Session were Associate General Counsels David Lieb and Carol Rubin of the Legal Department; and Ellyn Dye of the Commissioners' Office.

In Closed Session, the Board consulted with Legal Counsel about a request for reconsideration of the action on Preliminary Plan 12006040A, 8300 Wisconsin Avenue, which will be taken up on the open session agenda.

In accordance with the January 25 technical staff report, Planning Department staff discussed the request to create four lots for four one-family detached dwellings on a 0.85-acre property located on Geneva Avenue in Takoma Park. Staff noted that Geneva Avenue is a residential street with low traffic, and the proposed lots are of the same character as the existing lots in the neighborhood. Staff further added that the property does not contain any forest and there are no reforestation requirements but there is an afforestation requirement of 0.14 acres which can be satisfied offsite either by purchase of the equivalent credits from a private forest conservation bank or a payment of fee-in-lieu.

Mr. Bill Mytsak, Engineer representing the applicant, briefly discussed the proposed request and concurred with the staff recommendation.
