2. Limited Site Plan Amendment 82005024E to Amend the Forest Conservation Plan, Including a Tree Variance Request, National Park Seminary-WSSC Site 5-11 Stream Channel Rehabilitation

Planning Department staff offered a multi-media presentation of the request to amend the forest conservation plan, including a tree variance request, for the National Park Seminary – Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC) site to allow WSSC to perform required repairs and protection of existing sewer and water infrastructure. The proposed WSSC work includes stream alterations, grading, and associated forest clearing within a Category I easement area. The sewer system is in a degraded condition with temporary patchwork repairs. The property is listed on the National Registry for Historical Places and therefore requires a variance for the removal/disturbance of all associated trees. The access routes and disturbed areas will be reforested by WSSC.

There followed a brief Board discussion with questions to staff.

Planning Department staff noted that during the last worksession the Planning Board requested additional information regarding selected items in the Transportation Policy Area Review (TPAR) draft report, and these items will be addressed during today's multi-media presentation by staff and consultant Dr. Robert Winick of Motion Maps, LLC. These items were: i) Transit categories, standards, and adequacy – the Board requested new information on possible changes to the elements described in Exhibit 3.6 of the TPAR report; ii) Refinement of policy area categories – the Board requested additional information showing how policy area categories could better reflect future conditions for transit and land use development, such as that anticipated by the General Plan; and iii) Free flow speeds – the Board requested additional information regarding whether the free flow auto speeds derived from the application of the transportation model are realistic, i.e., do the free flow speeds compare favorably to posted speed limits.

At the Board's request the following Montgomery County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) representatives offered comments: Mr. Edgar Gonzalez, Deputy Director; Mr. Gary Erenrich, Special Assistant to the Director; and Ms. Anne Root of the Transportation Policy Division.

There followed extensive Board discussion with questions to staff and MCDOT's representatives.

6. Public Private Partnership with Coalition for Capital Crescent Trail (CCCT) - NEW TIME

CCCT has proposed to construct a trail plaza on the Capital Crescent Trail approximately 250' north of River Road in close proximity to Security Public Storage and Whole Foods Market in Bethesda. *Staff Recommendation: Approval*
