RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Montgomery County Code Chapter 22A, the Montgomery County Planning Board ("Planning Board" or "Boarc") is vested with the authority to review forest conservation plan applications; and

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2011, the Montgomery County Department of Parks of the Maryland-National Park and Planning Commission ("Applicant"), filed an application for approval of a forest conservation plan on approximately 27.8 acres of land located south of Brink Road on the east side of Ridge Road ("Property" o "Subject Property"), in the Germantown ("Master Plan") area; and

WHEREAS, Applicant's forest conservation plan application was designated Forest Conservation Plan No. PP2011001, Seneca Crossing _ocal Park ("Forest Conservation Plan" or "Application")¹; and

WHEREAS, Staff issued a memorandum to the Planning Board dated September 21, 2011, setting forth its analysis and recommendation for approval of the Application, subject to certain conditions ("Staff Report"); and

WHEREAS, following review and analysis of the Application by Planning Board staff ("Staff") and the staff of other governmental agencies, on C ctober 6, 2011, the Planning Board held a public hearing on the Application (the "Hearir g"); and

WHEREAS, at the Hearing, the Planning Board heard testimony and received evidence submitted for the record on the Application; and

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2011, the Planning Board approved the Preliminary Forest Conservation Plan on a motion of Commissioner Wells-Harley, seconded by Commissioner Anderson, with a vote of 5-0; Commissioner Anderson, Carrier, Dreyfuss, Presley, and Wells-Harley all voting in favor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the relevant provisions of Montgomery County Code Chapter 22A, the Planning Board AFPROVED Preliminary Forest Conservation Plan No. PP2012001 on the Property, subject to the following condition:

1. Provide a Final Forest Conservation Plan consistent with the preliminary Forest Conservation Plan for review and approval prior to any land disturbance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that having given full consideration to the recommendations and findings of its Staff as presented at the Hearing and as set forth in the Staff Report, which the Board hereby adopts and incorporates by reference; and upon consideration of the entire record, the Montgomery County Planning Board FINDS, with the conditions of approval, that:

1. The Application satisfies all the applicable requirements of the Forest Conservation Law, Montgomery County Code, Chapter 22A and the protection of environmentally sensitive features.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any party authorized by law to take an administrative appeal must initiate such an appeal within thirty days of the date of this

Resolution, consistent with the procedural rules for the judicial review of administrative agency decisions in Circuit Court (Rule 7-203, Maryland Rules).
