SUBJECT: FY11 User Fee Schedules – Montgomery Parks

---

**ACTION REQUESTED: Approval of proposed fee schedules for Montgomery Parks facilities.**

1. Approval of a comprehensive Montgomery County Department of Parks Fee Schedule document
2. Implementation and approval of Non Bi-County fee of 20% for FY11
3. Implementation and approval of priority registration for Montgomery County residents for program enrollment, beginning January, 2011
4. Approve proposed fees for Enterprise facilities, Park Permits office and Nature Centers
5. Recommended changes to the Policy on User Fees

Proposed and attached is a new User Fee Schedule document which when approved, will be published with all Montgomery Parks fees and posted on the Montgomery Parks website. The Enterprise Division and Park Permits Office is proposing the publication change in order to provide improved readability, while emphasizing the specific changes requested. The Nature Center's fees for interpretive programs and rental fees charged for their facilities will also be incorporated. Once approved, the document will be updated to reflect the effective date of the approved change. While new proposed fees and fees developed for a pilot program are listed in the Fee Schedule, changes to the current approved fee structure are provided in summarized form. The proposed fee document has provided the fees in four categories:

- Administrative Fees
- Admission Fees
- Course Fees
- Facility Rental Fees

Proposed is a new category of fees, Non Bi-County Fees for Event Centers, Park Activity Buildings and Little Bennett Campground. Customers residing in counties other than Montgomery or Prince George's County have not contributed to the funding for these facilities and staff is proposing a 20% increase over the Bi-County resident base rate. Affected facilities include the following:

- Little Bennett Campground
- Event Centers
  - Agricultural History Farm Park
  - Brookside Gardens
  - Little Seneca Lodge
  - Rockwood Manor
  - Woodlawn
- Ridge Road In-Line Rink
- Outdoor Basketball/Tennis courts
- Park Activity Buildings

- Picnic Areas
  - Local Park Shelters
  - Group Picnic Areas
  - Regional/Recreational Shelters
- Woodside Gymnasium

The Non Bi-County Fee is listed within the User Fee Schedule document and will not be duplicated in the summary of proposed fee increases.

Offering priority registration by **one day** to Montgomery County residents during program and class enrollment is an additional proposal; this ensures that the citizens who fund these programs through their tax dollars have the first option to enroll. After the priority registration period of one day, registrations are accepted from residents of all jurisdictions. The priority registration will apply to all Commission programs in Montgomery County.

Per the Park Department's User Fee Policy, Enterprise staff has performed its annual review of the Enterprise Fund user fees for policy compliance and cost basis, and presents its fee recommendations for your review and approval. The fee recommendations presented today are for FY11 and FY12. Upon approval of the presented fees and updated Policy on User Fees, they will be incorporated into the User Fee Schedule document and published online.

Unsolicited Public/Private Partnership Application Fee of \$5,000.00 for review, evaluation and processing the proposal for the Planning Board's review and presentation. Fee will only be accepted if the Department thinks the proposal to be financially and managerially self-sustaining, has the capacity to generate significant revenue to the Department, and is in fulfillment of an approved work project or program.

Permit Office staff has performed its annual review of the Permit Office User fees as well, and also presents its fee recommendation for your review and approval in this document. With the exception of the new local field fees, these proposed fee increases will take effect on July 1, 2010. Reservations made prior to July 1, 2010, will be honored at the current rate. The increase in local field fees will not take effect until the 2011 Spring/Summer season in order to provide user groups with time to accommodate the increases.

Regular and timely fee adjustments are necessary to keep Department fees competitive with comparable public and private self-supporting facilities or programs and/or to respond to market influences that affect pricing, user demand, etc.

Fees for certain family oriented activities, such as boat rentals, the carousel, and train rides, remain fairly static in the marketplace over a period of years, with only occasional, incremental increases.

The Parks Department's mission is to provide affordable and safe recreational programs and amenities for all. To help low income residents, the department provides a 50% fee reduction for general admission fees, group lessons and programs.

The Enterprise Fund facilities are mandated by the County Council to be completely self-supporting, including facility operating costs and debt service for new facilities.

Nature Centers are not charged with being self-sustaining and operate in a different budget framework from the Enterprise Division. Fees collected from Nature Centers go into the General Park Fund.

Staff is continually monitoring and assessing facility usage in an effort to increase participation. In light of the economic downturn, they have responded with creative programming. For example, Wheaton Tennis now offers additional camps combining instructional programs, Wheaton Ice Arena is offering "cheapskate sessions," and Cabin John Ice Rink offers a full day camp program at a reduced price. These actions have increased usage, participation and as a result, revenue. Having the flexibility to respond to the changing marketplace, through such vehicles, is necessary in order to keep the public returning to the facilities.

# PROPOSAL SUMMARY

## FY11 FEES

### ADMINISTRATIVE FEES

Some administration fees, such as security deposits, are not necessarily affected by market influences or inflation, and may remain unchanged for several years.

#### Park Permits Office

- Lost or Missing Key Penalty of \$150.00, assessed when Park Police are called off active patrol to open a Park Activity Building for a customer who lost or didn't remember to pick up the key
- A Special Event Application processing fee of \$50.00, non-refundable
- A Special Event Request Expedite Fee of \$150.00 charged only for event requests that are received within three weeks of the proposed date to cover the expedited review time spent by Parks staff and encourage event organizers to submit their requests with a longer lead time
- A \$2.00 fee increase from \$48.00 to \$50.00 in the current Cancellation and Change Fees

#### Brookside Gardens

- Administrative booking fee of \$50.00, to be credited to the customer's contract when a booking occurs as a result.
- New fee Equipment rental (LCD projector & Laptop Computer) - \$350.00
- New fee IT support - \$50.00/hour

#### Public/Private Partnership

- New fee Unsolicited Public/Private Partnership fee of \$5,000.00

### ADMISSION FEES

#### Brookside Gardens

- Holiday Light Show by \$5.00, for all fees charged; weekdays would be \$20.00 and weekends \$25.00 per car
- Adult Tours and Children's Classes from a group pricing structure to individual pricing, which would not penalize smaller groups. Proposed fees would be \$5.00/person.

#### Seasonal Facilities

##### **Miniature Golf and Splash Playground Fee Recommendations**

- Family (of 4) pass program - pilot program, \$95 for season
- Admission - \$4.50 to \$5.00, effective January 1, 2011
- Discount ticket books - \$40.50 to \$45.00, effective January 1, 2011
- \$10.00 per hour in party tent rental - large tent - \$40.00 to \$50.00; small tent - \$30.00 to \$40.00, effective January 1, 2011

- Local Park Athletic field fees are proposed to increase from \$3.00 to \$5.00 per hour.

## **Event Centers**

The following fee recommendations are based upon facility use and demand, and in an effort to remain competitive with the market. For all rental facilities, a rental is typically defined as any consecutive 8 hour period.

### **Agricultural History Farm Park**

Enterprise Division has assumed the responsibility of rental for the Agricultural History Farm Park and proposed fees are included in the Fee Schedule document. Since the addition of the approved seasonal fees for Enterprise Event Centers, the proposed fee structure was modeled on the current Event Centers. Note: Four hour rentals are only accepted within 45 days prior to the date.

- Activity Center, Saturday - \$1,550.00
- Activity Center, Four Hours - \$500.00
- Activity Center, extra hour - \$350.00

- Meadows, Extra Hour - \$350.00
- Engagement Photo Session, One Hour - \$350.00

### **Rockwood Manor**

- Eliminate meeting rentals during the season, after 5:00 pm Fridays through the weekend, unless within 45 days.

- Picnic Pavilions - \$100.00/4 hours, Locust Grove only

- Change from the seasonal use fee for charter youth groups, to \$10 hour weekdays, \$20 weekends, the same fee as a public agency or local municipality use

POLICY ON USER FEES**

**PURPOSE**

To provide direction and consistent rationale in the development and application of User Fees charged for facilities, services and programs in the Department of Parks, Montgomery County. These fees may be applicable to facilities, services and programs such as ~~recreation~~ **Park Activity** buildings, permits, ballfields, Brookside Gardens, group picnic areas, parking, Nature Centers, and ~~primitive~~ camping areas, which are primarily funded through general tax dollars. These fees are applicable to golf, ~~courses~~ ice rinks, indoor tennis courts, ~~conference~~ **Event** centers, miniature trains, boat rentals and rides, Wheaton Carousel, Little Bennett campground and selected activities at Brookside Gardens, which are self-supporting facilities, services and programs, and must produce sufficient revenue to cover both direct and indirect costs.

**POLICY STATEMENT**

Basic facilities, services and programs (such as trails, playgrounds and picnic areas), which appeal to a broad spectrum of the community, are supported by general tax dollars and are provided at no additional charge to residents. User Fees are charged for those facilities, services and programs, which provide an individual benefit or an exclusive use. User Fees may also be charged to balance use with capacity and demand, and to allocate scarce resources. When feasible, the User Fee charged should cover the direct and indirect costs of that part of the facility use, service or program from which the user derives the individual benefit. Fee reductions are given to qualified lower income individuals and groups, and may be given to qualified community based groups and qualified chartered youth groups. In general, User Fees should be higher for residents outside of Montgomery and Prince George's Counties.

User Fees for self-supporting facilities, services and programs are established at a level which (1) is competitive with comparable public and private facilities and services in the area; (2) can reasonably be expected to generate sufficient revenue to sustain administrative, administrative, operating, and maintenance costs; (3) is likely to generate surplus operating income to fund capital improvements at existing and developing facilities; and (4) reflects user demand and patterns of use.

**Criteria For Determining Whether A User Fee Should Be Charged**

The following criteria are considered before a User Fee is charged:

- The service can be provided only to the paying users, thus preventing access to all others.
- The amount of net revenue generated from the User Fee outweighs the difficulty and cost of collection.
- The application of a User Fee does not have a significant impact on usage.

## Fee Reductions For Lower Income Individuals and Groups

Qualified lower income individuals and groups are offered reductions on normal **User** fees to provide access to selected facilities, services and programs. Pursuant to County Council policy, costs not covered by lower income users will be absorbed by the general taxpayers, not by other users.

**Fee reductions may be applicable to facilities, services and programs such as:**

<b>Recreation Centers</b>	<b>Picnic Shelters</b>	Indoor Tennis Center
<b>Gymnasiums</b>	Miniature Trains	Brookside Gardens Programs and Facility
<b>Group Picnic Areas</b>	<b>Bus Parking</b>	Agricultural History Activity Room
Ice Rinks	Boat Operations	Nature Center Programs
<b>Primitive Camping</b>	Wheaton Carousel	<b>Park Activity Buildings</b>

Fee reductions are not applicable to merchandise sales, private lessons, bus trips, concessionaire operated facilities, use of ballfields by leagues and teams, some equipment and facility rentals or seasonal reservations. Reductions may not be applicable during peak attendance hours.

## Fee Reductions for Community Based Groups and Chartered Youth Groups

Qualified community based groups and qualified chartered youth groups may be offered reductions from normal **User** fees for use of ~~recreation centers~~ **Park Activity Buildings** and ~~conference~~ **Event** centers on weekdays. There may also be a charge to cover the operational costs of administration, security, and custodial services.

## Process for Determining Fees and Fee Reductions

Annually, staff from the Department of Parks will review each fee for policy compliance, and cost basis, to determine a fee recommendation. The Park Commission will review the staff fee recommendations and act on them. Approved User Fees will be reflected in the Department of Parks User Fees schedule.

The Department of Parks, in cooperation with the County's social service agencies, and the Department of Recreation, will establish eligibility guidelines, application procedures, and fee reduction levels for lower income individuals and groups, community based groups, and chartered youth groups.

Any reduction of fee not specifically mentioned in this policy must have the approval of the Director of Parks. The Director of Parks' determination will provide the final decision in this fee reduction process.

## Fee Reduction Program *Procedures and Application*

The M-NCPPC Montgomery County Department of Park and Planning (M-NCPPC) is committed to serving the needs of all residents of Montgomery County. M-NCPPC recognizes that many residents are financially unable to participate in the activities and programs offered in our fee-based facilities.

Therefore, M-NCPPC has established a Fee Reduction Program to make these facilities available to as many county residents as possible. A 50% fee reduction is awarded based on family income and/or outside public assistance (see the income criteria listed below). Reductions are available on selected user fees through a discount coupon book, program registrations, and facility rentals. See Page 4 of this application for a listing of the applicable fees.

The Fee Reduction Program is open to Montgomery County residents only.

### **HOW TO RECEIVE DISCOUNT COUPON BOOKS**

- 1) Submit applications for discount coupon books in person, Monday through Friday, during normal business hours, to any of the facilities listed on Page 4 of this application.
- 2) One coupon book of three discount tickets will be issued to each person in the family once the application is approved.
- 3) An application for more coupon books can be submitted at any facility listed on Page 4. However, only one application will be accepted for coupon books per day.
- 4) Coupon books do not have an expiration date.
- 5) Coupons entitle the bearer to a 50% discount on the user fees listed on Page 4.
- 6) For your convenience, coupon books can be applied for through the mail by sending the completed application to: M-NCPPC Hillandale Park Office, 10611 New Hampshire Ave, Silver Spring, MD 20903, or faxing the application to 301-434-4796. Allow up to 2 weeks for delivery.
- 7) Coupon books can be applied for and received when a qualified applicant completes this form for a program or facility rental (see below).

### **HOW TO APPLY FOR A REDUCTION ON PROGRAM REGISTRATIONS OR FACILITY RENTALS**

- 1) An application for a 50% fee reduction to the programs and rental facilities listed on Page 4 must be submitted to the respective office or facility administering the program or facility booking. An applicable registration form must be submitted at the same time.
- 2) Applicants for this reduction must compete for space in a program, class, etc., on a first-come, first-served basis the same as anyone else.
- 3) One application may be submitted for several members of the family, but each person will be permitted only one program/class/registration reduction per application and only one application will be accepted at a time.
