

The purpose of this letter to request M-NCPPC comments on the proposed abandonment of a portion of unimproved Somerset Lane in Colesville. For your reference I have enclosed a copy of the petitioner's request along with other information.

Please note that the applicant, Arthur Williams, through his consultant, MHG, currently is seeking a minor re-subdivision of his properties adjoining the subject right-of-way. Staff from both your agency and the County recommend that a public path traverse the area at a location to be determined but possibly sited within the existing right-of-way in which case part of the 60-foot wide right-of-way might need to be retained.

Pursuant to Section 49-62 of the Montgomery County Code 1994, the County Executive or his designee shall conduct a Public Hearing




